PRINCIPAL'S REPORT


Congratulations to Quoc Anh Do of Year 12, 2018 who received a service award at the Department of Education International Awards Ceremony last week.




Artist Chuck Close in his studio using the Grid method to create portraits

later practice of Chuck Close and begin to experiment with colour and design. Here are some wonderful images of their Grid work, well done Year 7!














