

SCIENCE



Year 11 Biology students have been investigating enzymes and their optimum performance conditions by conducting a range of experiments in the lead up to their practical assessment task.

Ever wondered why some people are lactose intolerant?

People with lactose intolerance cannot metabolise lactose properly, (a sugar found in milk and dairy products) because their digestive system produces too little of an enzyme known as lactase. Lactase is produced in the small intestine. The human body uses lactase to break down lactose into galactose and glucose, which is then absorbed into the bloodstream.

If lactase levels are low, the lactose does not break down and it does not absorb into the bloodstream. Instead it moves into the large intestine, or colon. Bacteria in the colon react to any product that contains lactose and they may experience bloating, flatulence, and diarrhea.



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
YEAR 12 PARENT TEACHER EVENING – CAREERS ADVICE
