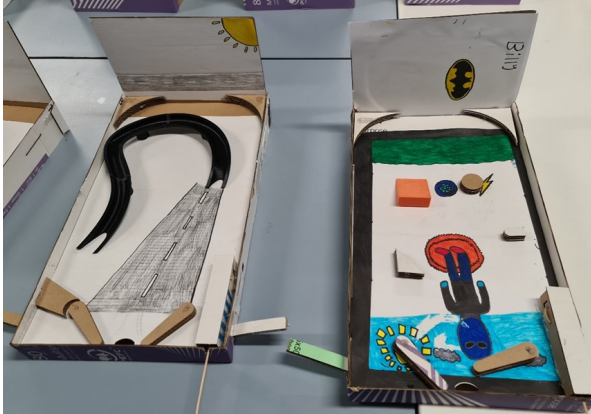

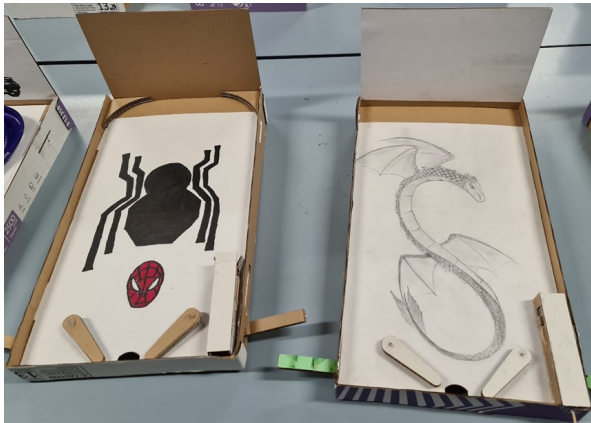
PINBALL WIZARDS

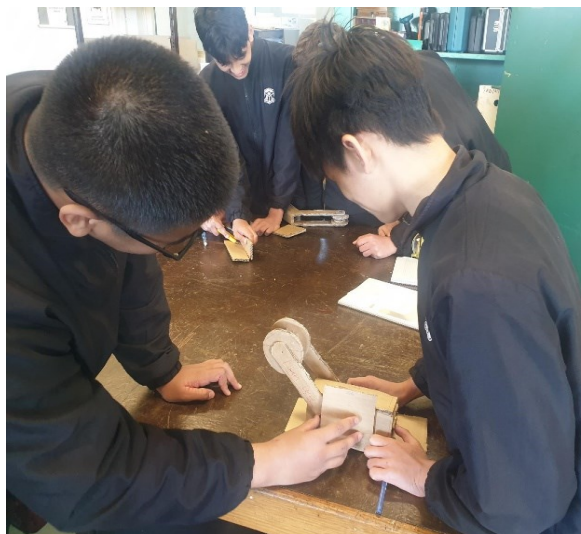

POWERFUL PULLEYS: ENGINEERING CHALLENGE

Year 9 Engineering students perform a simple demonstration to see the mechanical advantage of using a pulley, and they identify modern-day engineering applications of pulleys. In a hands-on activity, they see how a pulley can change the direction of a force, the difference between fixed and movable pulleys and the mechanical advantage gained with multiple and combined pulleys. They also learn the many ways engineers use pulleys.
