## **DISSECTING KIDNEYS AND CHICKEN WINGS**







8N has been studying body systems this term. The boys have been learning about the different systems that help us function and survive. They completed their first ever heart dissection to see one of the main organs in the circulatory system using dissecting equipment for the first time. Recently they had the opportunity to dissect a chicken wing and observe how you could move the wing by pushing down on a tendon. They also completed an investigation on the structures of the kidney. Despite the smell, the boys persevered and successfully navigated their way through each dissection.





## **ENGINEERING REPORT PRESENTATION**



## **QUIZZING AT HOME ON ACCELERATED READER**


Students can log into their Renaissance Reading account and take an Accelerated Reader quiz by using the link in their Google Classroom Library page or through their student portal.


